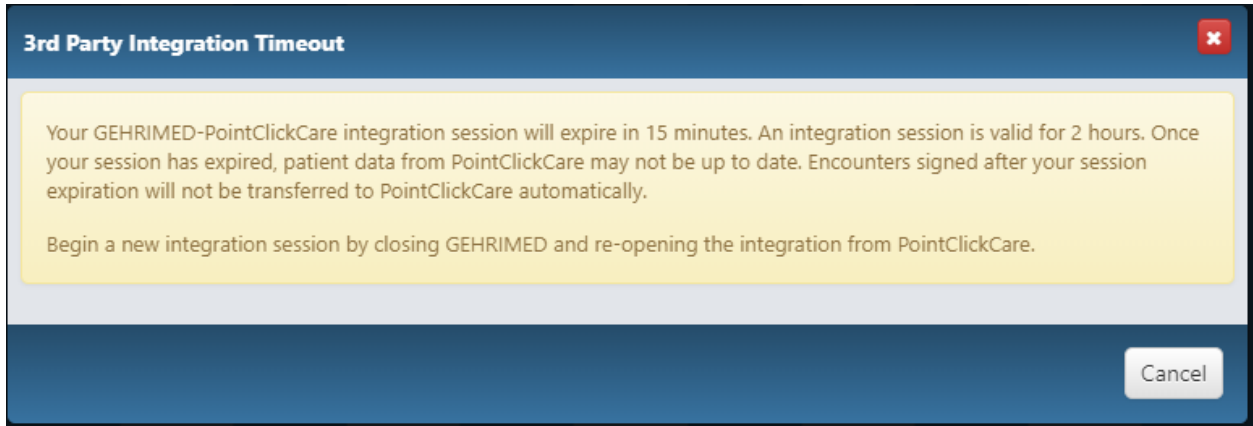


## Release Notes – Sep. 24, 2019

### Issues Addressed

- Users who access GEHRIMED from PointClickCare will be notified 15 minutes before the expiration of their session of GEHRIMED and to launch it again from PointClickCare to avoid sync issues.



- When importing a patient from PointClickCare to GEHRIMED via the PointClickCare integration the Admit date will now reflect the date entered in PointClickCare, and not the date the patient record was imported to GEHRIMED.
- Lab orders are now counted correctly for MIPS Promoting Interoperability.

### Feature Enhancements

#### User Account Summary Report

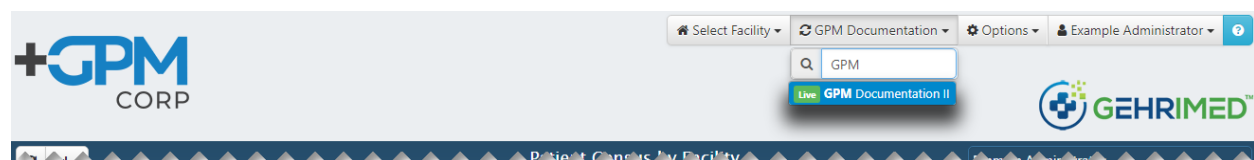
The User Account Summary report now includes additional information about the account configuration: Security level (User, Group Admin, Company Admin), User Type (User, Scribe, Physician, Non-Physician Provider), and Role permissions (which describe functionality the user has access to).

The User Account Summary report is available in GEHRIMED Reports on the first of every month.

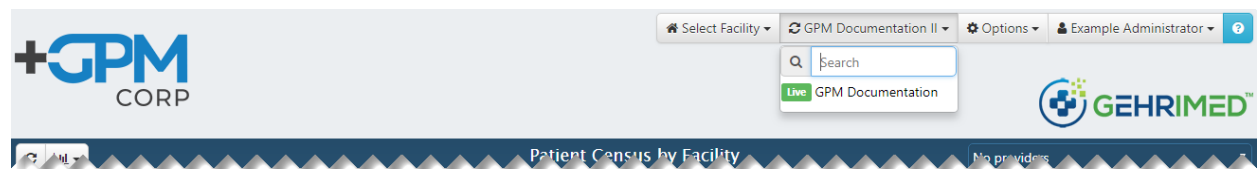

#### Group Switcher

The Group Switcher has been improved to make changing between groups easier for users with access to large numbers of groups. The Group Switcher is now a type-ahead:



Additionally, when a group is selected your home group appears by default in the drop-down before searching:

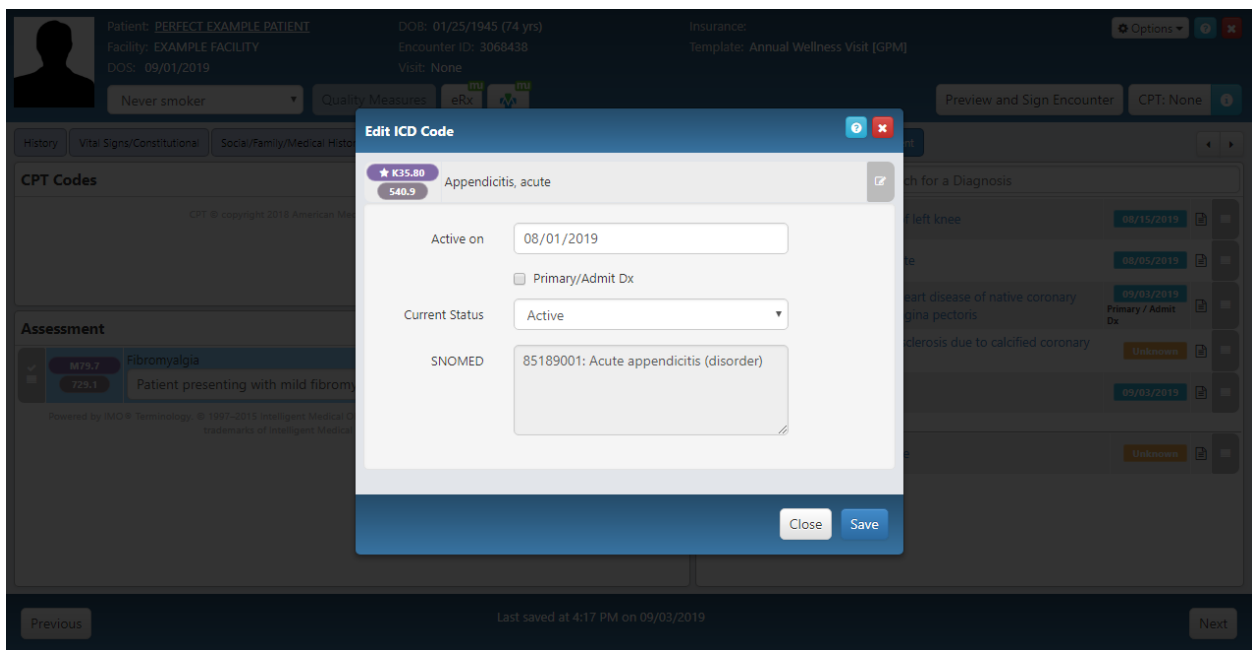


## PDPM Primary Admitting Diagnosis

To support facilities subject to the Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM) GEHRIMED provides clinicians the option to choose a Problem Code associated with a patient as their Primary Admitting Diagnosis.

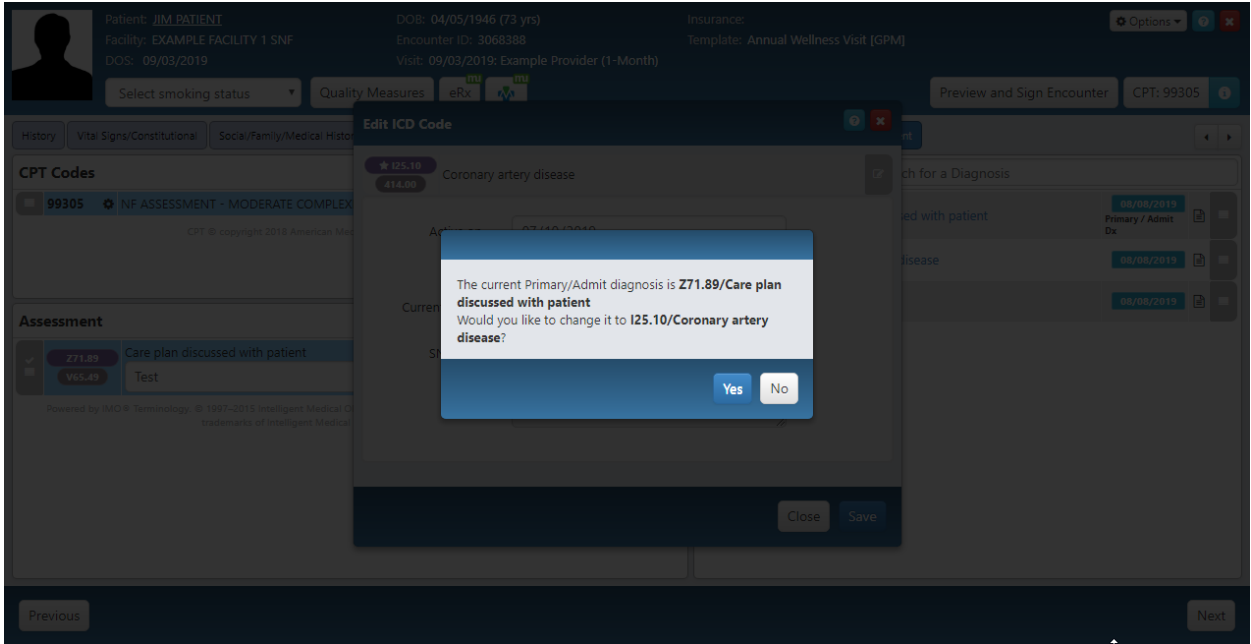
### To Set the Primary Admitting Diagnosis

1. From the Manage Problem List window in the Patient Details, or the Problem list in an encounter, launch the Edit ICD Code window:



2. Select the **Primary/Admit Dx** checkbox and select **Save**

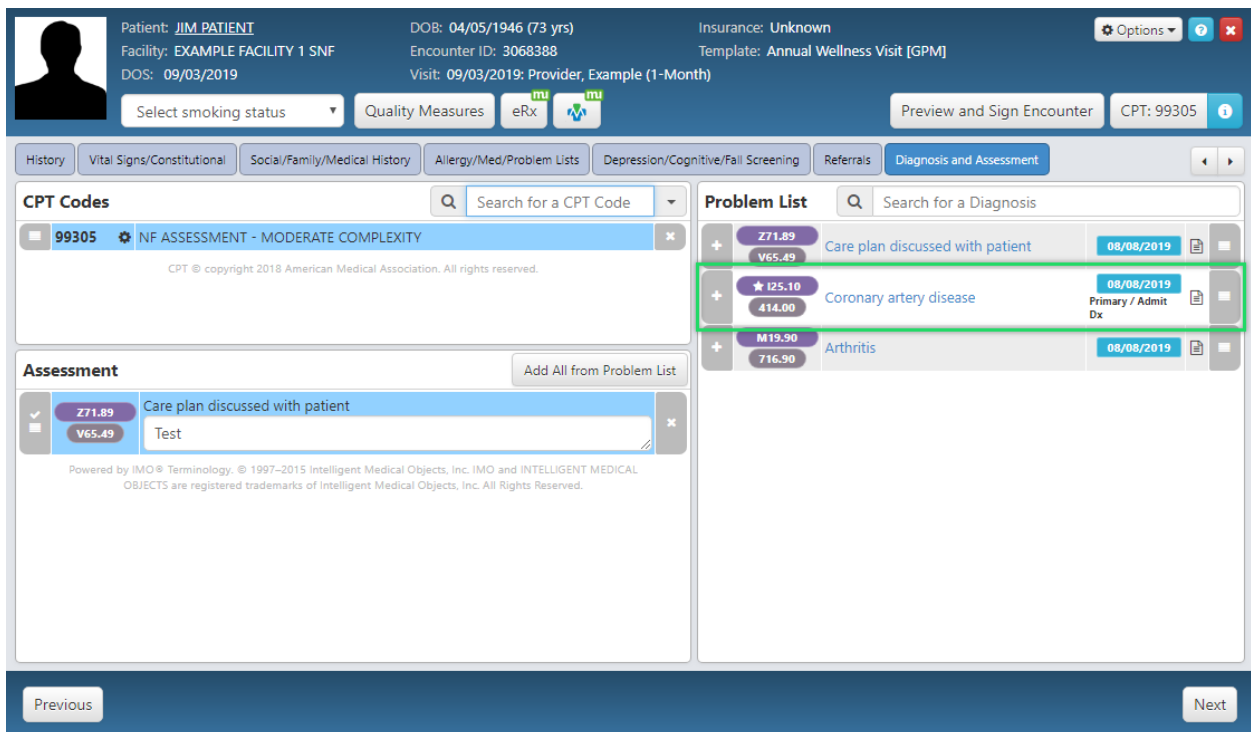
**Note:** If a Primary Admitting Diagnosis Code is already set for the patient, a warning is displayed to the user:



Select **Yes** to change the Primary Admitting Diagnosis

3. The Problem Code is set as the Primary Admitting Diagnosis.

Once the Primary Admitting Diagnosis has been set, it will be labeled as such on the problem list:



Additionally, when the Problem Code set as the Primary Admitting Diagnosis is included on an encounter, the signed encounter will include a label communicating the Primary Admitting Diagnosis:

## Replicate Assessments

The GEHRIMED Encounter Diagnosis and Assessment tab has been updated to increase ease of use in the Encounter workflow. Providers may now replicate assessment text from previous encounters, either per ICD Problem Code or all ICD Problem Codes from the most recent signed encounter.



1. Add an initial Problem Code to the Assessment:

**NOTE:** The replicate previous assessment function, like the previous function, will always pull from the most recent signed encounter associated with the patient, regardless of the chronological date of the unsigned encounter.
