Issues Addressed

- Pop-up information on the Patient Census will now display in-line with the associated patient when selected, instead of in the top left-hand corner.

Feature Enhancements

PointClickCare Medications and Allergies

GEHRIMED users with an active PointClickCare integration may now view and copy medications and allergies from PointClickCare to a GEHRIMED encounter.

The Medication List and Allergy List encounter Items for a patient record imported from PointClickCare will now include an **Import PointClickCare** button if the user has the PointClickCare integration:

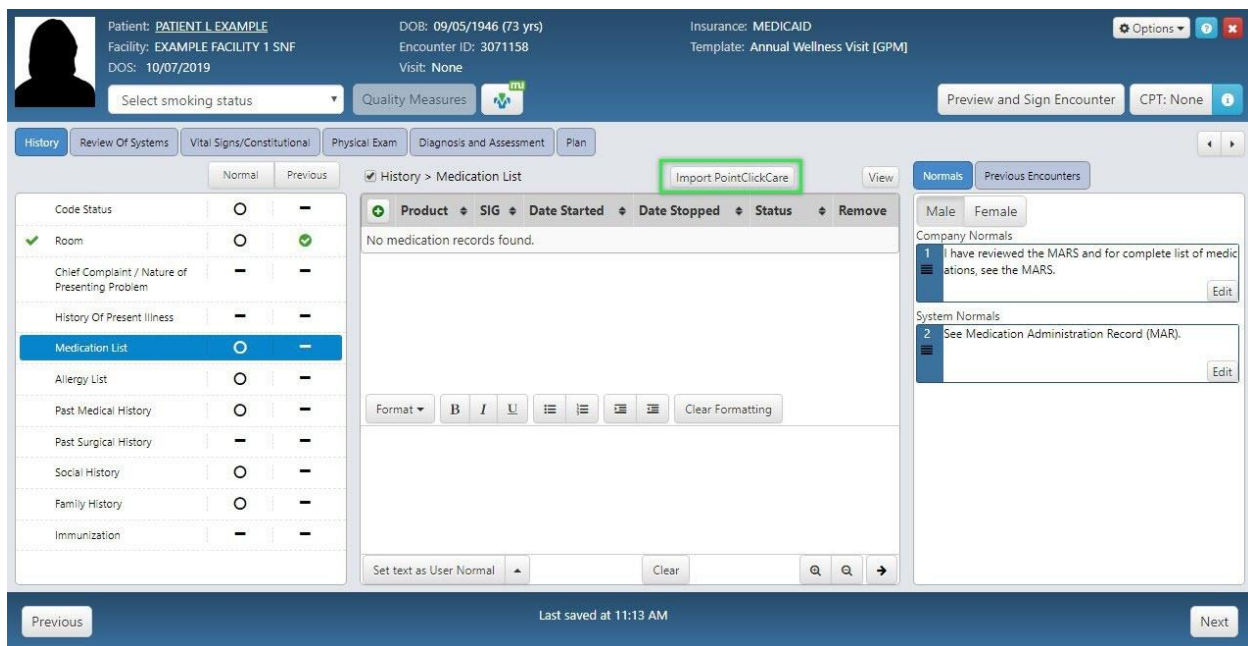


Figure 1: Medication List Encounter Item

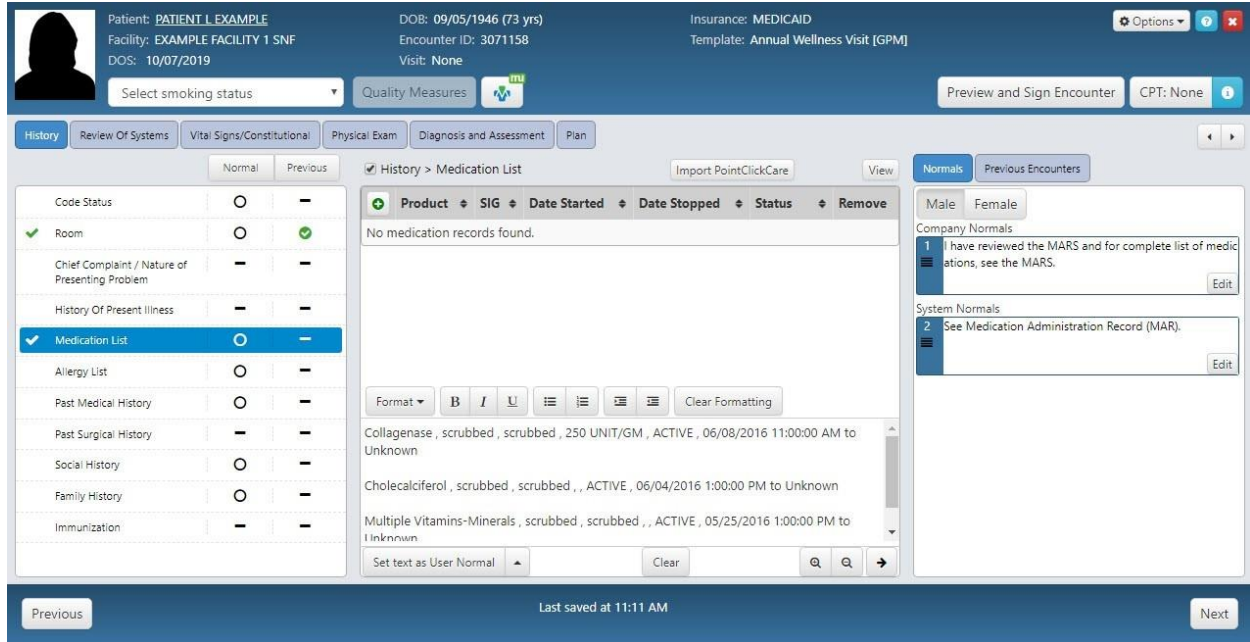


Figure 4: The Medication Encounter item with items copied from PointClickCare

Scheduling

Improvements have been made to Scheduled Visits, enabling the creation of recurring visits for patients, bulk deleting of scheduled visits, and the use of Dragon Speech recognition when editing visit details. These changes have been designed to improve provider workflow around creating and managing patient visits.

Visit Types

Practice administrators may now assign an interval to Visit Types that will set the default visit date for a scheduled visit based on the selected visit type:

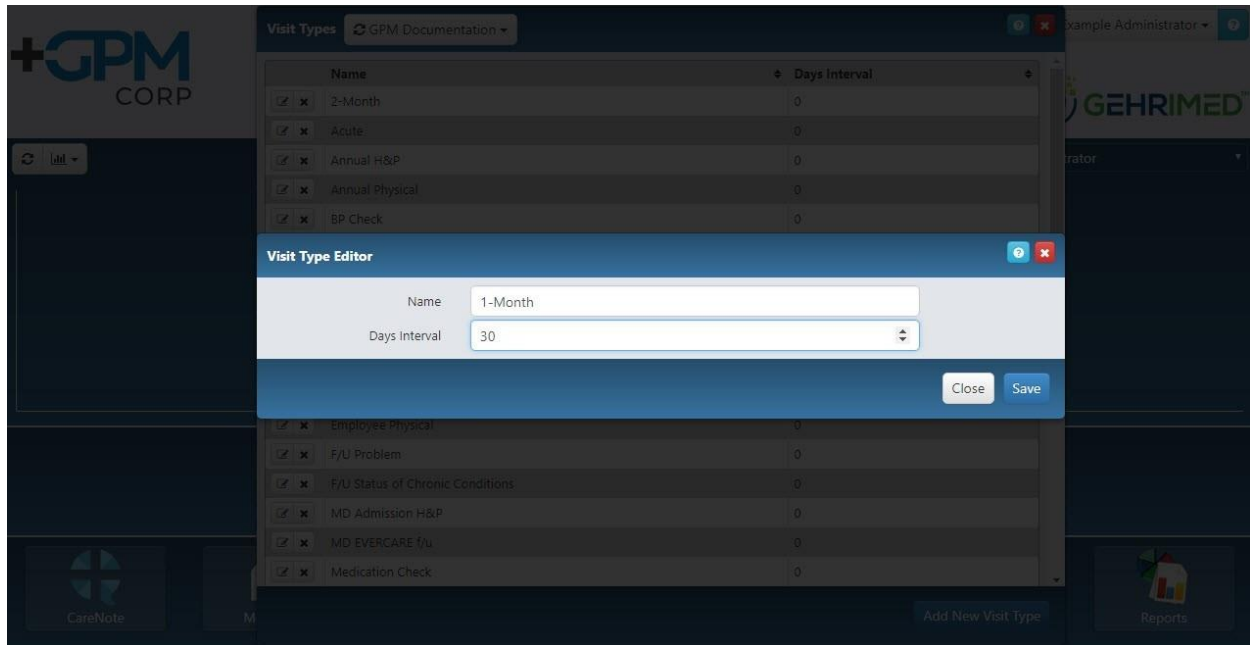


Figure 5: The Visit Type Editor.

Custom Recurring Visits

Additionally, recurring visits may be created on a per patient basis:

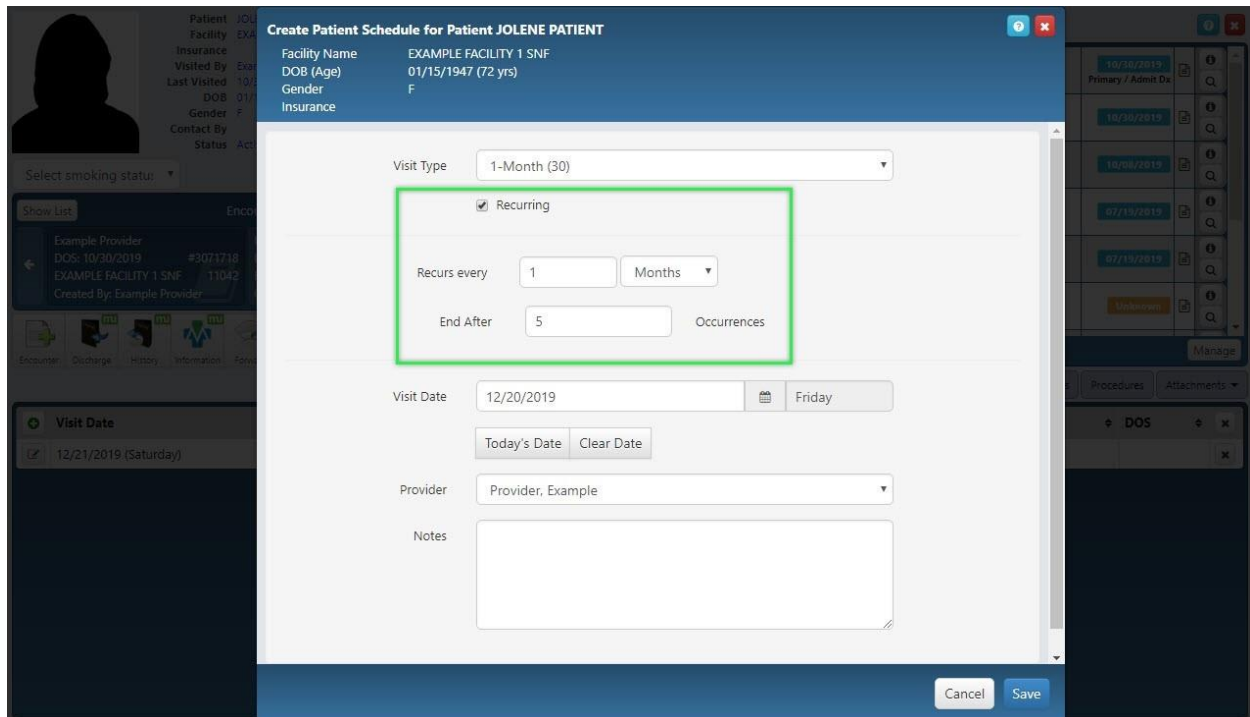


Figure 6: The Create Scheduled Patient window for a patient. Recurring visit options will not display unless the box is checked.

Using the recurring visit functionality, a clinician may create several visits on a set schedule. Clinicians may use recurring visits to schedule out mandatory patient visits.

CareTeam Referral Management

GEHRIMED users may now view unclaimed referral codes in the Facility details, and may generate a referral code email for the email delivery contact:

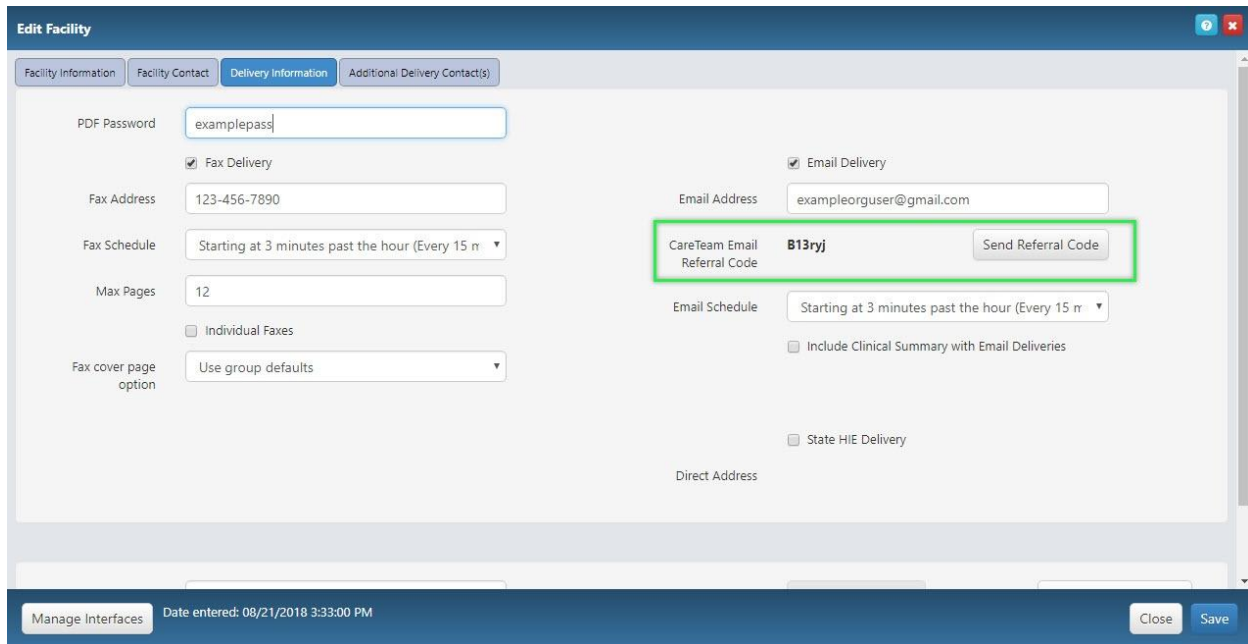


Figure 7: The Edit Facility window. If no referral code has been sent, it will display 'Unknown'.

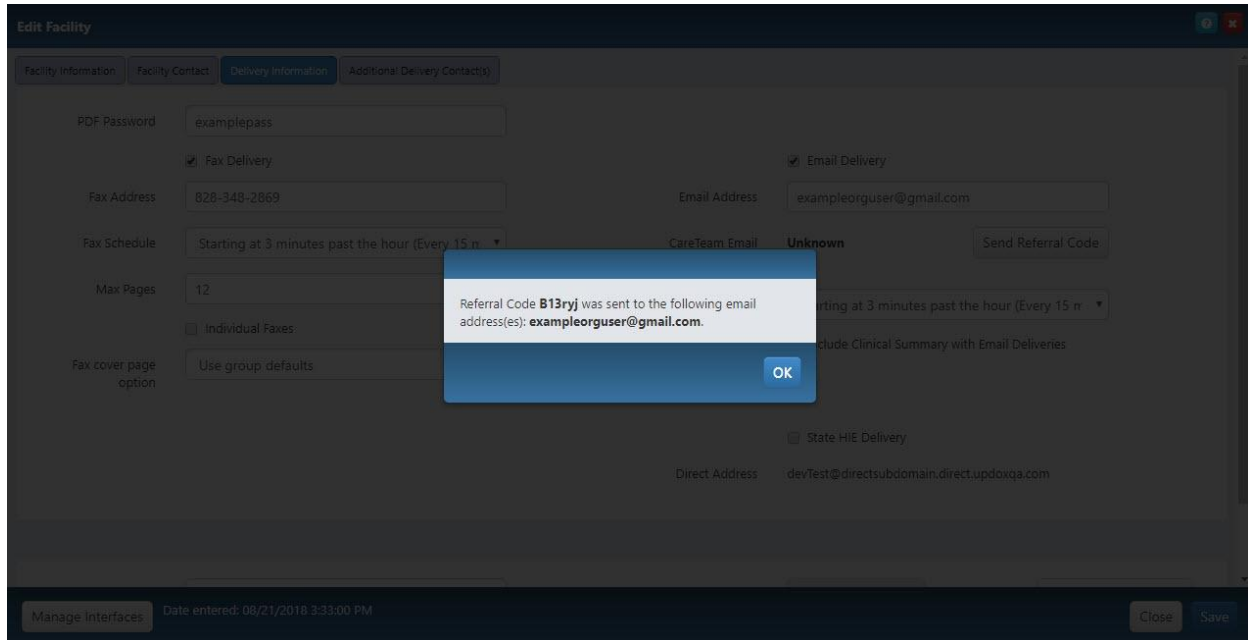


Figure 8: A confirmation is displayed when a referral code is sent to the delivery email.

GEHRIMED Administrators may use this feature to send or resend the CareTeam referral code and enables the GEHRIMED Administrator to view the unclaimed referral code.

Rcopia Prescriber Agents

Prescriber Agents in GEHRIMED now have access to the Pending Prescriptions/ Refills window, enabling them to view and manage refills for all their patients:
