Issues Addressed


A GEHRIMED bug that caused batch CCDA generation to fail has been corrected. When an error causes a CCDA inside the batch to error, the batch generation will now continues, skipping the error record.

A Null Date of Birth will no longer cause a CCDA file to error.

Feature Enhancements

Directory Listing PHI Warning

Adding or editing directory listings will now prompt a warning and confirmation before save to ensure notification of PHI delivery:











Encounter Primary Billing Diagnosis Restriction

GEHRIMED Administrators now have access to a new option on the group details that places a restriction on the ICD codes that may be added to the Encounter's Primary Billing Diagnosis:



NOTE: This feature is enabled by default.

Once enabled, your providers will be unable to sign an encounter if a non-primary diagnosis code (denoted by an icon and determined by Intelligent Medical Objects©) is listed as the Primary Billing Diagnosis:












Custom ICD and CPT Restrictions

CPT-ICD Restrictions may now be created by GEHRIMED Administrator users. When a CPT-ICD Restriction is active for a group, providers are warned that the ICD Code cannot be the Primary Billing Diagnosis on an encounter.

To setup CPT-ICD restrictions select the Manage CPT-ICD Restrictions option in the Options Menu:












Select New CPT-ICD Restriction button to launch the Create CPT-ICD Restriction window:



Search for the appropriate CPT-ICD combination:



Select the **Save button** to add the CPT-ICD Code Restriction.









Once you have established a CPT-ICD Combination(s), your providers will receive a warning when selecting the **Preview and Sign** option:



Note: Providers are not prevented from signing the encounter.
